A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNHALL SANITARY SEWER
MUNICPAL AUTHORITY SETTING FORTH CERTAIN POLICIES
AND FIXING RATES, CHARGES, AND FEES FOR THE USE AND
BENEFIT OF SANITARY SEWER SERVICES TO PROVIDE FOR
THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SANITARY
SEWER SYSTEM

NOW, THEREFORE, by and on behalf of the Board of the Munhall Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority, it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. EFFECTIVE DATE

The policies, rates, charges, and fees set forth herein are hereby imposed and established for the use and benefit of the sanitary sewer system and sanitary sewer services provided by the Munhall Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority ("Authority") within the Borough of Munhall ("Borough") commencing on the 1st day of January 2019 and continuing for each year thereafter, unless otherwise amended or repealed.

SECTION 2. WATER CONSUMPTION

Where rates, charges and fees depend upon the volume of water consumed by a property, such measurements shall be provided to the Authority by the Pennsylvania American Water Company ("PA American").

SECTION 3. RATES, CHARGES, AND FEES

The rates, charges, and fees for the use and benefit of sanitary sewer services shall be as follows:

- A. One (1) Equivalent Dwelling Unit ("EDU") shall equal 203 gallons per day as calculated in accordance with the Munhall Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority Tap Fee Resolution of August 26, 2009. The charge per each EDU shall be sixteen dollars (\$16.00).
- B. All properties connected to the Authority's sanitary sewer system shall pay a minimum monthly fee equivalent to the charge for one (1) EDU, regardless of actual water consumption.

C. Nothing shall be construed to relieve the owner of liability for rates, charges, and fees for sanitary sewer services provided to the property.

D. All unpaid rates, charges, and fees for sanitary sewer services, from the first day due and together with any interest, penalty and costs, shall become a lien against the property.

E. The Authority may delegate who the Billing and Collection Service it uses.

SECTION 6.

If any sentence, clause or section, or any part of this Resolution is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionally, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this Resolution.

SECTION 7.

All prior resolutions that conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed only insofar as is necessary for the provisions herein to have full effect, and the remainder of such other resolutions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 8.

This Resolution is intended to be read in conjunction with the FEES and CHARGES Resolution 2018-01 set forth by the Authority, which set the delinquent and penalties for failure to pay any monthly service rentals or usage fees.
